The National Research Foundation (NRF) seeks to make an appointment for the position of Monitoring and Evaluation Professional Officer who will report to the Monitoring & Evaluations, Planning and Reporting Manager: SAASTA, within Research, Innovation and Impact Support and Advancement (RIISA) at the business unit SAASTA.

The purpose of this job is to develop and maintain Project Management processes and collate, collect, analyze different data set of project activities. This includes contribution towards the implementation of evidence based approach by leveraging on technology for improved data quality, enabling real time monitoring systems for learning and decision making purposes. The position will be based at NRF RIISA business unit SAASTA in Pretoria CBD.

# **Key Responsibilities:**

- \* Design, develop, plan, and implement project assessment and evaluation activities. This includes development and dissemination of tools, materials, reports, papers, and intervention-linked research;
- \* Develop operational work plans targets in line with the M&E division and Organisational Business plan;
- Cultivate strategies and develop related tools for the design and implementation of monitoring of technical variables of specific projects in consultation with project managers;
- \* Monitor and evaluate the implementation of SE plans to establish potential bottlenecks, recommending corrective actions and to ensure the quality of reporting, internally and externally, (SAASTA, NRF facilities and DSI entities).
- \* Allocate and deploy committees to evaluate the respective science centre within two weeks after they complete self-evaluation;
- Coordinate logistical arrangement for all meetings in line with the operational and financial policies;
- \* Provide secretariat support to both peer and accreditation meetings;
- \* Assist the committees with the packaging and circulation of agendas, minutes of meetings and related documents by the timelines set;
- \* Review peer and accreditation reports for quality assurance;
- \* Package reports for submission to the DSI for ratification and signing of Accreditation Certificates through the Manager and MD's office within two weeks of receiving the reports.
- Coordinate both peer and accreditation evaluation meetings;
- \* Provide technical support and advice to committee members; and
- \* Provide training to peer and accreditation committees;
- \* Cultivate strategic M&E partnerships to build relationships and alliances with other M&E partners for professional development through presentations and participation at conferences, workshops, meetings, etc.
- \* Provide technical advice to both internal and external stakeholders;
- Utilize financial resources effectively to ensuring that project expenditure is within budget;
- \* Plan and compile project costs for budget inputs.
